

CPR/First Aid

Contestant report time - 9:00 am, Saturday, March 16th, 2018.

Location – Greenville Convention Center, Room 201

Contest Attire - SkillsUSA scrubs with white tennis shoes or athletic shoes

Required Equipment - Bring a breathing barrier - not a BVM

Required Documentation - Health Care Provider or Professional Rescuer Level CPR either through Red Cross, American Heart Association, National Safety Council or any other nationally accredited, advanced level CPR program. You will also need Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) or a basic First Aid certification, or paperwork verifying you are currently enrolled in a EMR or Basic First Aid course.

Judges - Are EMT certified and certified with and American Heart. We will follow the current America Heart Association standard, however differences in protocols will not be penalized.

Contest Scope -

Two Person CPR with AED for an adult

Two person Infant CPR

One Trauma emergency

Two Medical emergencies

You will have a 25 question test that will be taken after all competitors have finished the competition, which will be used in the need of a tie breaker. After the contest we will have a de-briefing with all competitors.

*Important - Differences in Training

Every certifying body has slight differences in procedures. You are not being judged on that. You will be judged on how effectively you are handling an emergency medical situation. Your confidence, your decision making, and your use of generally accepted techniques in First Aid/CPR are what are being judged.

Spectators – You may watch your competitor compete. Competitors are not allowed to watch other competitors.
