Special Notices

- * All State Safety and Sanitation Procedures are expected to be followed at all times throughout the competition.
- *All Rules will be followed as listed in the Skills USA Technical Standards for The Cosmetology Competition.

Class F Dress Code: Clothing Penalties will result in point deductions. *All Contestants must be in uniform during designated contest times.*

Student Kit Check: Contestants will present to the judges all required items located on the supply checklist. All items and kits must be clean, organized and sanitary.

Written Examination: Contestants will have 45 Minutes on a written assessment based on knowledge of Esthetics

Oral Communication: At the conclusion of each competition portion. Judges may ask contestants to explain their theme choice, development or methods of applications. Contestants are asked to keep their explanations brief and under 2 minutes.

Acrylic Nail Application: Sculpt an acrylic nail using forms. No tips will be allowed. This will be done on the models left hand. This will later serve as the base for the Fantasy Nail Art Competition. Only 1 Color of Acrylic may be used. (The color of the acrylic will not be judged). All-State Safety and Sanitation Procedures are expected to be followed at all times throughout the competition

Nail Tip with Gel Application & Wearable Nail Art: On the models right hand, demonstrate proper application and blending of nail tips. Demonstrate the application of light-cured gel nails. Create a simple, wearable nail art design. The contestant may choose colors and basic nail art designs. No premade pieces, stickers, or stencils may be used. Rhinestones, "Chrome" type powders and small add-ons are allowed with limited use. This is designed to be a daily wear look.

Polish Application and Fantasy Nail Art:

Contestants will create a fantasy nail art design on the left hand. A specific theme is to be carried through all 5 fingers. (Contestants may choose the theme) Nail Polish is to make up at least 80 % of the final design. The creativity of theme, artist expression, color coordination, level of difficulty, precision, neatness, and clarity of lines will all be considered in judging. No stickers or stencils will be allowed. All 3D Style Effects must be created on-site during the competition time.

Kit Check Supplies & Standards

- Clean Portable Kit
- First Aid Kit / Blood Spill Kit
- Disinfectant jar (for implements with disinfection solution)
 - 1 Paper Bag Labeled Trash

(All paper bags are to have a plastic bag located inside opened inside like a trash bag)

- Safety glasses for contestant and model
- White terry towels (no holes or stains allowed)
 - Disposable towels for the table
 - Water Bottle (optional)
- All items necessary to complete five sculptured acrylic nails. Note: Dappen dishes much have covers; monomer, polymer and primer must be from the same manufacturer. Any Color may be used, but will not be included in the judging.
- All items necessary to complete five nails with a tip and light-cured enhancement overlay. Can be a hard gel or a hybrid gel/acrylic product. Note: Gel polish, temporary or no-light gels may not be used
- All items allowed to complete the flat nail art application: Medium choices: acrylic
 paints, polishes/lacquers, colored powders (acrylic and dip), gel polish,
 rhinestones sizes 20ss and under, glitters and dusts, and adhesives, i.e., gel top
 coats/glue Note: No pre-prepared items can be used; items are limited to those
 intended for use on nails. Top coat may be used as a sealer.
 - Hand Sanitizer
 - Hospital Grade Disinfectant for surfaces, equipment, and implements.
 - Client Safety and Protection Supplies
 - Product Application and Removal Materials
 - Manicure table lamp and electrical extension cord If needed

Contest Guidelines (Adjusted to fit State Schedule)

- Contestants will submit all required information at the time of check-in/registration
 - Following orientation, contestants will be required to be dressed in official contest clothing, provide items for the kit check, take the written cosmetology knowledge test
 - All contestants must keep their working area clean and organized at all times.
 - All contestants must follow sanitation and safety procedures throughout the contest at all times. Floor monitors/judges will assess decontamination procedures and safety practices throughout the contest.
- All contestants must provide their own models for the competition

1. Points may be deducted for the following reasons:

- 1. Any rule not followed, with no exceptions
- Leaving the competition area before completion of task (applies to both contestant and model) without proper escort
- 3. Unauthorized use of a product that is not allowed or that doesn't appear in the above listing
- 4. Any product that appears to have been altered. All products and solutions must be properly identified with the manufacturer's original packaging and original labeling. Product labels cannot be defaced.
 - 5. Professional attitude and communication is expected throughout the contest
 - 6. Once time is called, the contestant must stop working. Touching the model after time is called will result in three penalty points.
- 7. Cellphones are not allowed in the contest area. If models and/or contestants are using any digital communication device, (other than when permitted), points will be deducted.
 - 8. Setup should only consist of items needed for the specific task in progress. Time will be allowed between each task to reset the table. All items should be brought to the contest site in an organized fashion.
 - 9. Required implements and products must be clean, accounted for and professionally organized. Proper control and usage of products and tools will be expected at all times.

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- 10. Any form of communication with observers, judges and other contestants are prohibited during the contest.
